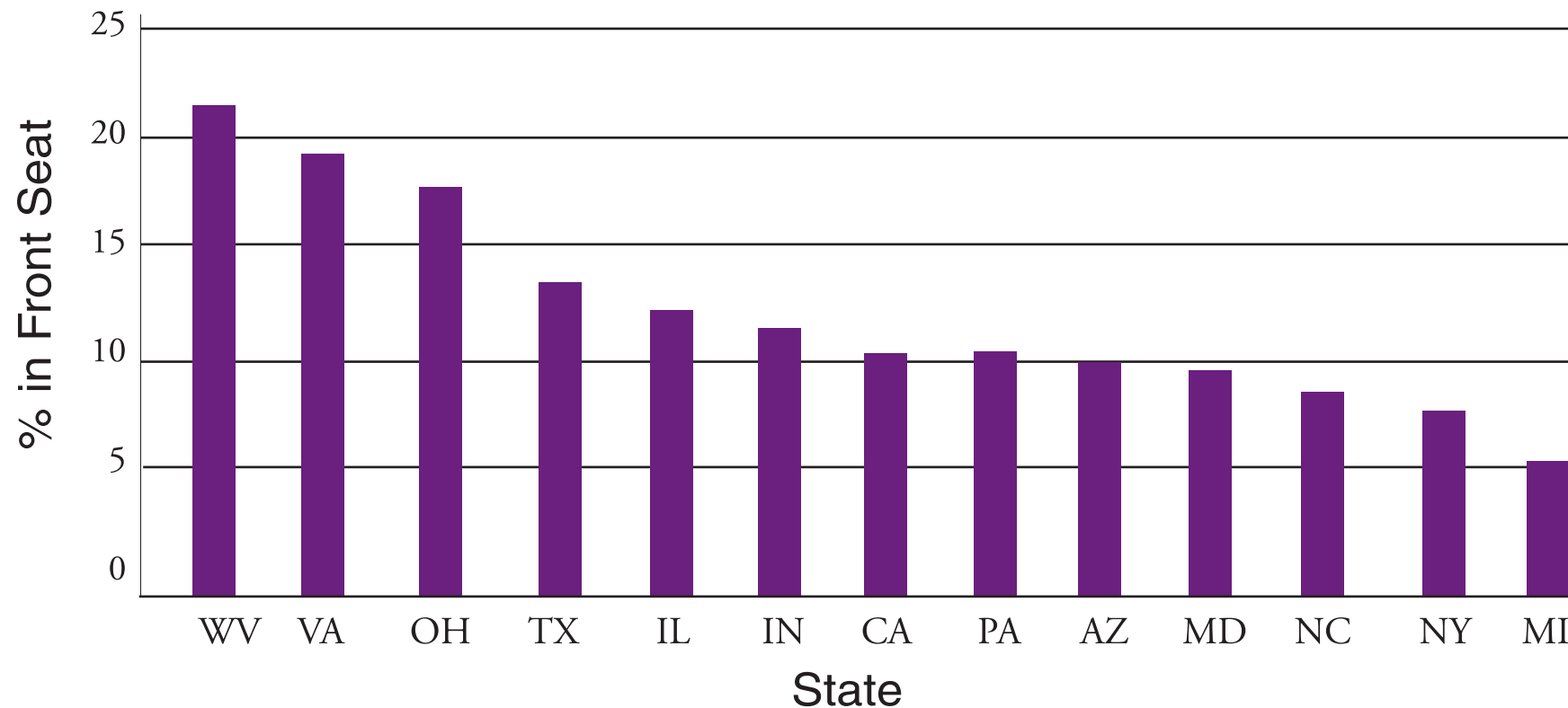


Children 0 to 12 Years Old Seated in the Front Seat in 2005



Children are at a greater risk of injury in the front seat than in the rear seat. By restraining a child aged 0 to 12 years in the rear seat, parents can reduce the child's risk of injury in a crash by 38 percent. Education should emphasize rear seating for children.
